Dear parents,

For this new school year, we want to share the ParentSquare Alexa skill. With the ParentSquare skill, you can get school updates by asking Alexa. Using the Alexa app or any Alexa device, you can ask *“Alexa, does Hannah have any school updates?”* or *“Alexa, are there any school messages?”*. Alexa will respond with information available through your ParentSquare account.

To get started, follow the steps below to set up.

Scan the QR Code to enable the ParentSquare skill from the Alexa app.



Don't have the app? Download it by searching for “Amazon Alexa” within the app store on your device. Install the app and login using your Amazon credentials.

1. On the ParentSquare skill's page, click “Enable To Use.”
2. Login using your ParentSquare app credentials.

If you don't have an Alexa device, you can download the latest version of the Alexa app, login with your Amazon account, and follow the steps above to set up. Once set up, just open the Alexa app or use your Alexa device and start asking Alexa for school updates.
